What is MedWish?

MedWish diverts between 500,000-600,000 pounds of medical surplus from our local landfills every year. This is done with the support of local hospitals and healthcare providers, manufacturers, and individuals who generously donate medical supplies and equipment to MedWish.



What is MedWish?

Roughly 3,500 volunteers support MedWish annually and help sort and pack donated supplies. MedWish is also training site for individuals with special needs through MedWish's Skill Building Program.



Once supplies have been sorted and packed, they are distributed around the world through our International Humanitarian Aid Program and locally through our Local & Domestic Giving Program. We also have an Alternative Recycling Program for supplies that do not meet the requirements of medical aid.

Medical Supply and Equipment Recovery Program

- Last year, MedWish diverted over 600,000 pounds of supplies and equipment from our local landfills.
- The MedWish truck will pick up donations from any corporate location.





Last year:

- Volunteers donated over 15,000 hours of service through our Skill Building, Intern, and General Volunteer Programs
- MedWish partnered with 12 Skill Building Groups





International Humanitarian Aid Program

- MedWish has shipped to 114 countries since being founded in 1993, including local giving in the United States.
- Last fiscal year, MedWish shipped over 302,000 pounds of supplies and equipment.











Local & Domestic Giving Program

- Established in 2018.
- MedWish has partnered with over 180 agencies to date.
- Last year, MedWish distributed over 128,000 pounds of supplies and equipment through this program.











Alternative Recycling Program

- MedWish partners with domestic nonprofits to repurpose supplies unfit for humanitarian aid distribution. They are no longer sterile and/or are expired, and therefore cannot be distributed for medical use.
- We work with schools, animal shelters, and other local organizations.
- Through this program, MedWish distributed 42,194 pounds in 2021.
